#### /olunteers Needed


We are looking for anyone who can volunteer an hour or 2 once or twice a week to help us improve our school grounds. This will include some gardening and a general maintenance.

## Dear Parents and Carers,

Our new online system to pay for lunches will launch next week, on MONDAY 3rd July!

To ensure your children can have the lunches they want we need you to sign up and register.

You need to sign up and register, even if your child receives Free School Meals (FSM).

With the new system you pay for and order meals for your child. You can do this daily, weekly or in advance, the choice is yours.

Meals will have to be chosen by 9am everyday, if nothing is chosen the children will be given a standard jacket potato. Over the initial first few weeks, teachers will be able to

select lunches for children during registration, but eventually this will be left to you.

We will also no longer be taking dinner money payments in the office. Dinner Money will need to be paid using this new online system.
