In Year 1 our first topic will be 'Memory Box'. We will be learning about changes over time, family and community. We will be talking about and understanding special memories, traditions and growing up.

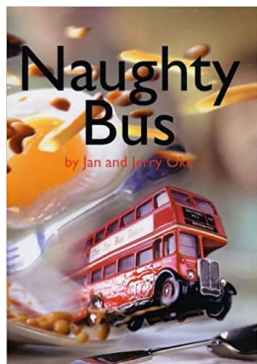


In science we will be learning about animals and humans. We will be exploring and asking questions about animals in their habitat. We will understand how to take care of animals.

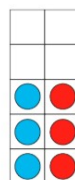

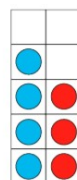
In English we will be reading Naughty Bus by Jan and Jerry Oke. We will be learning to write letters.
