Your class teachers will be Mrs Nizamis & Mrs Rodgers

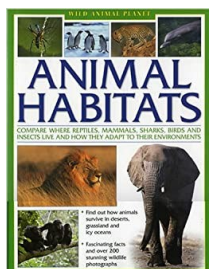
Our class Teaching Assistant is Mrs Akhtar

You will start your day with a task, it might be reading, writing or maths.

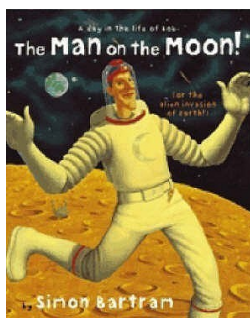
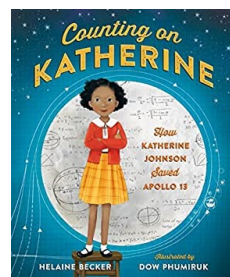
In Year 2 our first topic will be 'Moon Zoom'. We will be learning all about space and when people first landed on the moon.



In science we will be looking at animals and their habitats, maybe you could find out about this at national Geographic kids:

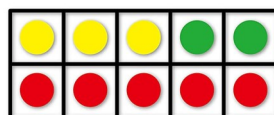
